Our Depute Head. Key remit includes second level Primary 5, 6 and 7.

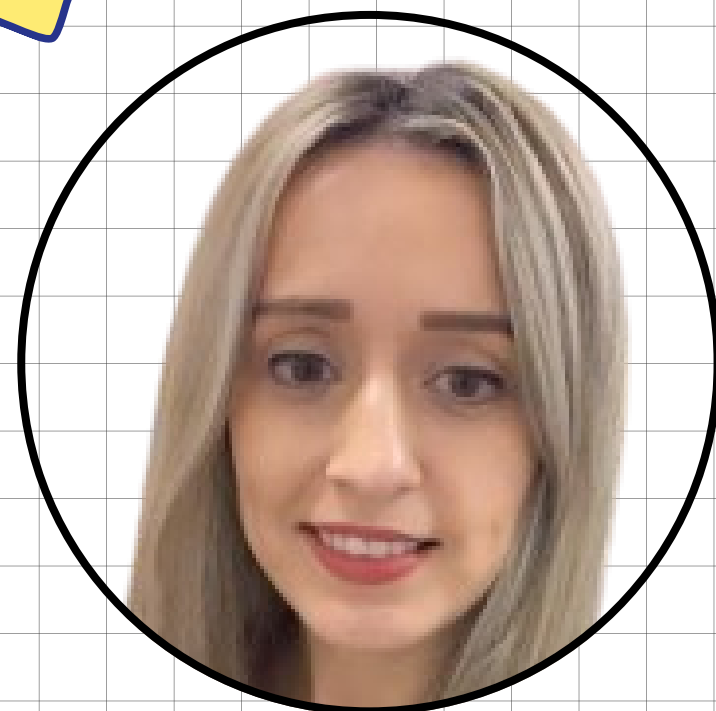
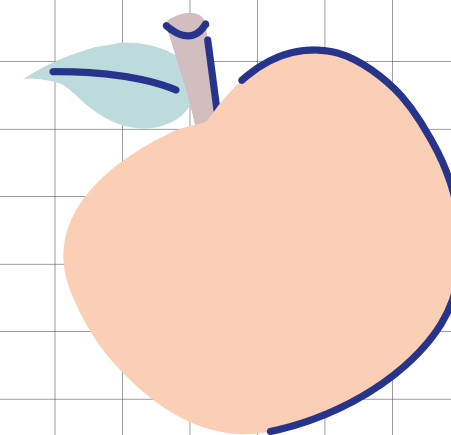


MRS THACKER

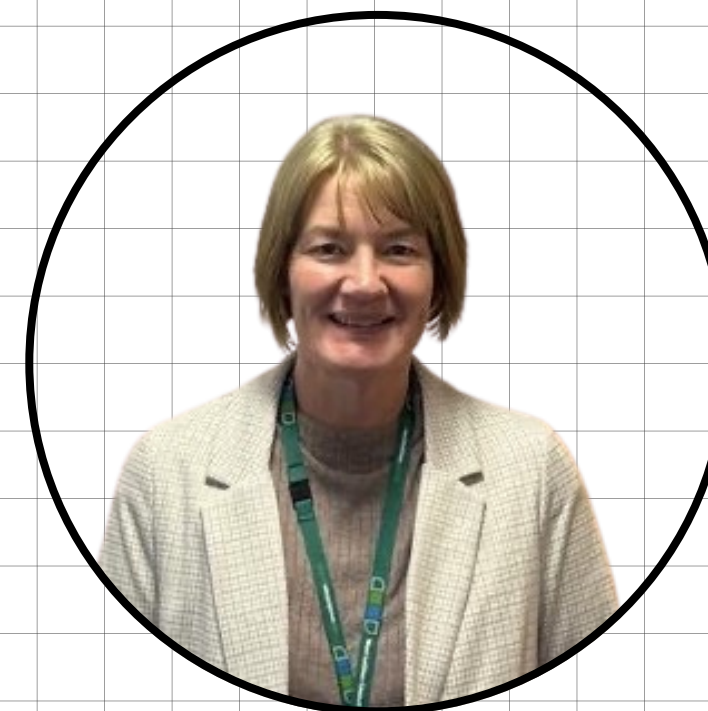

Our targeted support teacher for the upper school. Miss Potter is also Forest School trained.

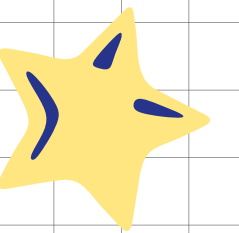
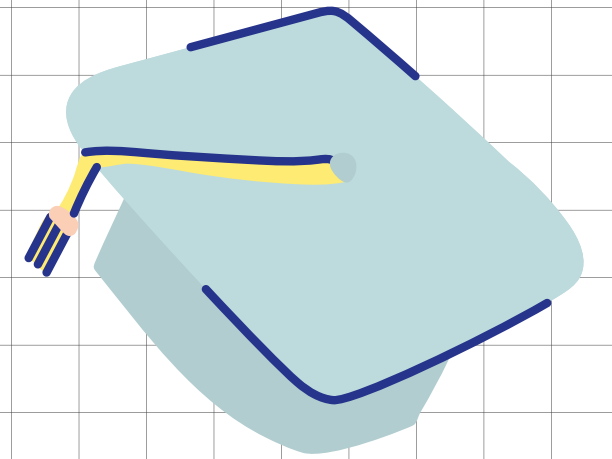

Our Support for Learning Teacher. Miss Buchan will also be working with Primary 1B and Primary 6 this session.



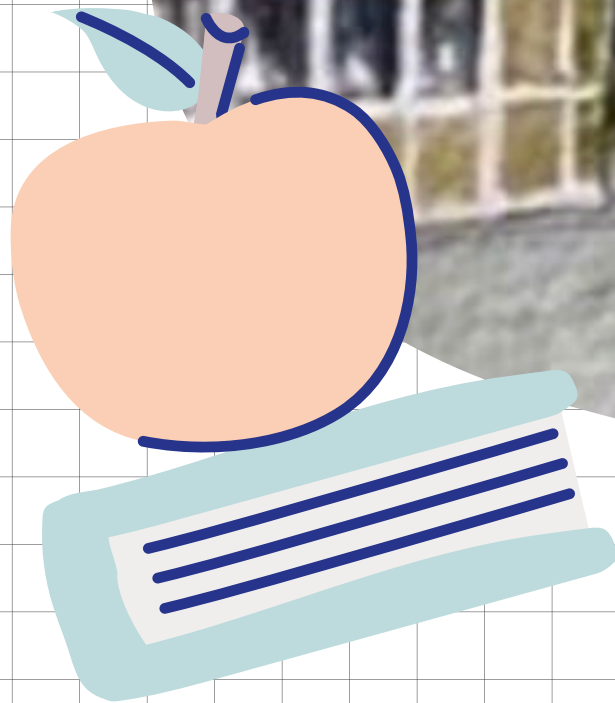

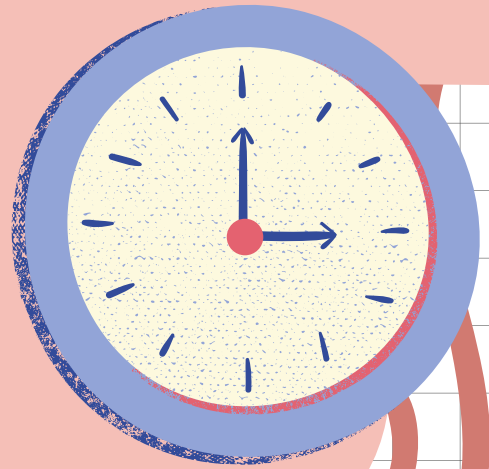
PROMOTING POSITIVE BEHAVIOUR

HOMEWORK

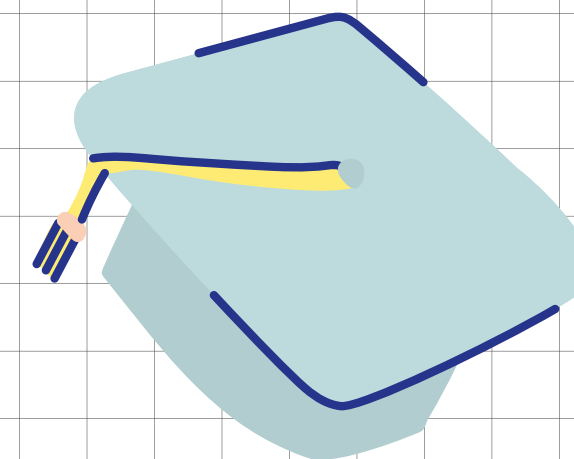
The first homework to start up will be reading.

Tricky words and Numeracy homework will begin in coming weeks.

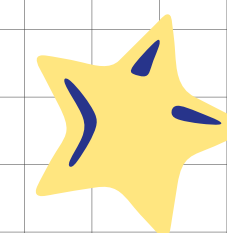
